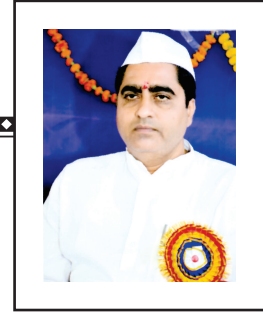

ADMISSION RULES

1. Application form & a copy of Prospectus of the college can be obtained from the college office. Application for admission to the college should be as per the notification of the college on the Notice Board of the college.
2. The students from outside Maharashtra Board and University, desirous to admit for Degree Course of the University, Nagpur on payment of the prescribed fees of 220/- as per letter No. of Enroll RTMNU/FAO/R/600, dt.30 June 2010 of R.T.M. Nagpur University, Nagpur.
3. The application form must be filled in by candidate's own handwriting and must be duly signed by Parents/ Guardian of the candidate who will be responsible for her.
4. For admission to all classes, original School / College Leaving or Transfer Certificate, Marklist and True copies attested by Gazetted Officer, Principal, Headmaster or Lecturer of affiliated college of Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University, Nagpur should be submitted at the time of admission.
5. Five recent passport size photographs with the applicant's full name written on reverse should be submitted with the Application Form.
6. A student admitted in the college has to pay the fees and other dues for the entire session. Once the admission is taken the fees will not be refunded in any case. Transfer certificate will not be issued unless the entire amount of the fees is paid. The original Jr. College Leaving Certificate will not be returned after admission.
7. The Principal has authority to refuse or cancel admission once granted if a student is found guilty of misconduct or misbehavior or any act of indiscipline.

CONCESSIONS AND SCHOLARSHIP

1. Government of India scholarship

For a student belonging to SC/ST whose parent's income is below Rs. 2,00,000/- P.A. & for VJ/NT/SBC/OBC income is below Rs. 1,00,000/- P.A. will get concession. Failure / repeaters will get any concession. Cast Certificate, Income Certificate and Mark list are required along with the application form.

2. National merit scholarship

This scholarship is available for student who has obtained 60% Mark all above in the qualifying examination. This scholarship is subject to the sanction of the Director Education, Pune.

3. Military concession

For students whose parent is/ were in the Military Department, military concession is available. Submission of necessary certificate is mandatory.

4. Freedom fighter scholarship

This scholarship or financial assistance is available for a student whose parents have been honoured as Freedom Fighters. A student will have to submit necessary certificate to the effect.

5. Free ship for primary, middle and high school teacher.

6. Scholarship for handicapped student.

7. Scholarship for students belonging to the minority communities.

LIBRARY-RULES AND REGULATION

1. The time of library and its rule will be declared on the notice board.

2. Students have to return book within 15 days. Neither student have to pay penalty charges (50 paise) per day.

3. If the book is lost by the students he has to return to the Library the period of two week will be given to the students. As he has informed to the librarian.

4. The students have to sign within column. After returning book has to demand a signature forms the concerned clerk.

5. Reference book will be not taken away from the library.

6. Student will be responsible for the mis-use of the book.

7. If the book is damage. He has to inform to the librarian.

NOTE:-

a. For the use of the books and its damage the students have to pays Rs. 25 per Year.

b. The book must be returned before the examination if he wants book he has to pay the extra the amount.

c. After examination the students have to return book with in session result day, neither there will be penalty Rs. 2 Rupees.

OTHER DETAILS

1. College Examination :-

The home examinations, unit test, terminal and test of the college will be held on the dates fixed by the College Council. Every student must appear in all these examination. Absentees without prior permission will have to pay fine of Rs. 25/- per paper.

2. Attendance :-

In order to qualify as candidate per University Examination, every student must attened more than 75% of lectures and practical's delivered in every month in each of their subject of study. It will entirely be the responsibility of the student to keep regular attendance.

3. Uniform :-

Uniform is compulsory for all students to attend the college every day.

Boys :- Yellow Shirt and Black Pant.

Girls :- Yellow- Black Salvar and Black Dupatta .

ACTIVITIES NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (N.S.S.)

N.S.S. has been introduced as main stream activities at the college level. CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE STUDENTS

1. Student is expected to attend minimum 75% Theory and Practical Classes. No student shall remain absent from any unit test or college test examination. Student shall have to pay the fine as decided by the Principal on remaining absent for either theory or practical classes without seeking prior permission from the respective teachers.
2. Student having less than 75% attendance will be considered as defaulters and their names will be removed from the rolls and will not be allowed to appear in University Examination.
3. Off period, if any, may be spent in Library reading room or in student's common room. Student shall not unnecessarily loiter in the college premises or in the corridors.
4. No one will be allowed to live the premises during the college hours without permission.
5. Student is expected to obey all the instructions and behave respectfully to word the guests, their teacher, other teaching staff and non teaching staff of college.
6. Any change in the subject, faculty of medium will not be allowed unless permitted by the Principal.
7. Election of University Students Council only shall be held as per the provisions and directives from the Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University, Nagpur.
8. There shall be no Students Union/ Council in the college and hence no election of the office bearers.
9. Any change either in the local or permanent address of a student should be informed to the office in writing.
10. Students are expected to keep their bicycles, two wheelers in the parking space provided. The vehicle should be properly locked.
11. Only special notices shall be circulated in classroom and general notice will be displayed on the Notice Board Students are therefore, expected to see Notice Board From time to time.
12. Any difficulty faced by the student should be brought to the notice of the Principal through the Faculty Incharge.
